



New Uniform



The Knights of Columbus board of directors unanimously voted to adopt a new uniform for the Fourth Degree. The decision was made with the good of the entire Order in mind. While we understand that some members may prefer the old regalia, the supreme master and vice supreme masters urge all Fourth Degree members to put the good of the Order before any personal preference.

The board decided to make this move based on the following factors:

- the aging of our Fourth Degree membership
- the slow growth of the Fourth Degree (fewer than 20 percent of Knights are Fourth Degree members, and only a fraction of that number even serve as honor guards)
- consistent reports that the old regalia presented a barrier to Fourth Degree membership, especially among younger men
- the preference is for the new uniform wherever possible, the old regalia can still be worn until the end of the current fraternal year (June 30, 2018). After that date, only the new uniform should be worn.
- Dark suit for new candidates at the fall and spring exemplification.



RESOLUTION APPROVAL

In order for Resolutions to be presented at the Supreme Assembly Meeting, the following procedure must be followed:

- The assembly votes on Resolution(s) at their monthly meeting.
- The Resolution(s) is given to the Master for his approval, then to be presented at the Biennial Meeting
- Master presents Resolution(s) to Vice Supreme Master for his approval.
 Resolution(s) must be typewritten, in correct form, and accompanied by this signed approval form.
- Vice Supreme Master will approve and submit paperwork to Supreme for presentation at the Supreme Assembly Meeting.

NOTE: No Resolutions will be accepted at Supreme unless approved and submitted by the Vice Supreme Master, along with this signed form.

Ohio District 3 will hold the Mandatory Biannual District meeting for the purpose of nominating qualified candidates to be a Master of the Fourth Degree of the Knights of Columbus. Supreme has mandated that per the Supreme Laws Governing the Fourth Degree of the Knights of Columbus, **Article V, Section 14** District Assemblies, that biannually on even years in the months of March or April the Master shall call a meeting for the purpose of the selection of three recommendations for Master.

Per the Supreme Laws Governing the Fourth Degree of the Knights of Columbus, Article V, Section 14 District Assemblies, sub section (a) The District Assembly shall be composed of the current Navigator of sub Assemblies, plus one delegate for every 100 or fraction there of Sir Knights on the Assembly Roster as published by Supreme on January 1, of the year the meeting will be held.



The Names of the Navigator, Delegate(s) and the Alternate(s) must be mailed to the District Executive Secretary and received prior to March 1, 2018 to be eligible to vote. However, in lieu of mailing the completed form you may e-mail the names of your Delegates.

If your Assembly wishes to nominate a Brother Sir Knight to be nominated for the next Master of Ohio District 3 then his name and a short bio, itemizing why you believe he would make a good Master should also be forwarded to the District Executive Secretary prior to March 1, 2018. His name will then be added to the Ballot and your Assembly will be allowed a 5 minute Nominating Speech and a 2 minute Seconding Speech. You may nominate someone from a different Assembly than your own; however each Nominee will be allowed only one Nominating and one Seconding Speech. Additional Seconds will be taken by Assembly Number only and recorded as part of the Official Record.
